## THE CASE

In a case involving conspiracy for market manipulation through a commercial bribery scheme, a U.S. law firm (the "Client") represented a XYZ company (the "Company") who was alleged to have conspired with various other market players in a commercial bribery scheme to rig bids. It was alleged by the plaintiff that a multi-billion-dollar market was impacted by the bid-rigging and commercial bribery conspiracy. The complaint had quite a few defendants named in it, including the Company. The court, therein, allowed the so named defendants to file a joint Memorandum of Law in Support of their Motion to Dismiss, and individual Motions if the individual defendants so require. The Client was in favor of filing both, the joint Memorandum of Law and an individual Memorandum of Law.

# THE INSTRUCTIONS

The Client retained SKJ Juris to draft two Memorandums of Law in Support of a Motion to Dismiss – a joint Memorandum of Law and an individual Memorandum of Law. The individual Memorandum of Law had to be not more than 8 pages.

# THE CHALLENGES

The challenge was to draft an individual Motion Brief of 8 pages in response to a 65-page complaint highlighting the defects in the allegations against the Company, and to draft an all-encompassing joint Motion Brief of around 30-40 pages, within a tight deadline.





#### THE APPROACH
